

National University Journal of Science Instruction to Authors

National University Journal of Science is a multi-disciplinary research and review journal published half-yearly. Its scope includes experimental and theoretical works on physics, chemistry, mathematics, statistics, bio-chemistry, computer science, zoology, botany, geography, psychology and environmental science. The Journal publishes originally research papers and short review articles on any branches of science and their applications.

The authors are requested to follow the following rules in **preparing the manuscripts** for submission:

1. **The paper should have:** a) Title page (page 1) which should include (i) Title of paper; (ii) Name(s) of author(s); (iii) Complete address of the institution/laboratory where the work was conducted; (iv) Name, telephone number(s), e-mail address of the author to whom all correspondence may be made. Authors must not write names anywhere other than in the first page.
2. **Two copies of the manuscript** written in English in A4 size papers with 2.5 cm margin should be submitted. [Once the manuscript is accepted, the computer copies in MS Word are expected to be submitted in CD along with two final hard copies]
3. **The title of each article** should be brief, clear and specific.
4. **The title page** should be followed by abstract. An abstract not more than 200 words highlighting the findings, important results and particular method should be provided.
5. **Tables** should be typed in the body of the text and numbered serially in numerical order as they are mentioned in the text. Each table should bear a descriptive title and be referred in the text by respective numbers.
6. **Photographs** should be of high-contrast glossy, black and white prints. All original figures, plates, photographs should be numbered on the back with author's name and title of the paper. **Diagrams** should be made with black ink or computer-generated black on high- quality white paper or other comparable material.
7. **References** should be numbered in order and these numbers should appear within third brackets in appropriate positions in the text. All references of a manuscript should be typed in alphabetical order in separate sheet(s) under the heading "References". Author should follow the style below:
 - (i) Porter, C. E. and Thomas, G. E. 1956. *Phys. Rev.* **104**, 483 (for journal).
 - (ii) Quittner, P. 1972. Gamma ray spectroscopy, Adam Higher, London, p124. (for book).

(iii) Rahim, M. A., Khan, M. S. and Islam M. R. 1989. Proceedings of the third World Conference on Neutron Radiography, Osaka, Japan, may 14-18, p. 240 (for Proceeding).
